POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Attendance Policy

- Every effort should be made to keep absences to a minimum, as there is so much to learn and experience!
- Students must attend at least 80% of classes in order to advance to a higher level.
- Carefully check the school calendar regarding school closings and special programs. Please adjust your schedules accordingly.

Arrival and Dismissal

- Please make every effort to arrive on time and to stay until the end of the class session.
- Wednesday class hours are 4:45 - 6:30. The school is open 15 minutes early for snack. Once class begins, snacks are to be put away.
- Sunday class hours are 9:30 - 12:30.
- Parents should arrive 10 minutes before class ends and stay in carpool line for teachers to bring children out to you. This allows everyone, teachers included, to leave school on time.

Behavior

- Respect is an important aspect of Jewish learning at DRRS. Students and staff are asked to respect each other and the property of others at all times. This year our Mensch Chart will be our main behavioral guide.
- As part of Derech Ertz, consideration for others, it is customary for students to invite their entire class to their B'nai Mitzvah celebration.
- Any items brought to school that disturb class will be taken by the teacher and returned to a parent at pick up.

Classroom Placement

A child's grade in religious school will usually correspond with their grade in public or private school to ensure the child's academic and social well-being.

Homework

It is our policy that homework may be assigned by any teacher and will be given when appropriate. The length of time needed to complete any assignment will be reasonable.

School Supplies

To make it easier for the students, they should come to class prepared by bringing appropriate books, assignments, and materials.

During Religious School, boys are required to wear kippot. **Sport hats are not permitted.** Girls are encouraged to wear kippot.

Inclement Weather Policy

DRRS closes with Anne Arundel County.

If AACPS has not closed or called for early dismissal, DRRS will make the call by noon on Wednesdays or 7:30 on Sundays.

Communication

DRRS office will make every effort to keep you informed of events via e-mail.

Teachers will communicate by phone and letters regarding your child's progress. Evaluation cards will be distributed twice a year. We encourage you to come to us with any questions or concerns as they arise.
